Letter Identification Memory Uppercase Letters

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out letter cards.
- 2. Mix cards up and turn them over face down.
- 3. Play with a partner.
- 4. Take turns turning over 2 cards and saying the letters. If the two letters match and you can name the letter, you keep the cards and get another turn. If the two cards don't match or you can't name the letter, turn them back over and it's your partner's turn.
- 5. When all matches have been made, count your matches to see who collected the most matches.
