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<u>Letto</u> <u>Uppercase Letters</u>

Instructions:

- I. Have each child chose a gameboard. Place letter cards face down in a draw pile in the middle of the table. Place markers (pennies, buttons, stones, plastic chips, or any small objects) in the middle of the table or give each child some markers.
- 2. Choose a child to go first. Play will then proceed to the right.
- 3. On their turn, each child takes a turn drawing a letter card and showing and telling what letter it is. If enrichment of the game is needed, have each child also tell the sound that letter makes and name something that starts with that sound.
- 4. Children search for that letter on their gameboards. If a child finds this letter on their gameboard, he or she will place a marker on that space or spaces on their gameboard. If a letter appears in more than one space on their gameboards, a marker is placed in all spaces with that letter.
- 5. The first child to cover all spaces on their gameboard wins. The game can then continue until other children have covered all spaces on their gameboards, if desired.
- 6. When children finish the first game, they can clear their boards and play again. If desired, children can trade or chose a new gameboard.
- 7. The child who covered his or her gameboard first in the first game starts the second game.
